

MSPP Internship Consortium in Clinical Psychology
Application Information for 2012-2013

Please electronically submit a detailed cover letter, current resume/CV, clinical work sample and 500 word responses to each Essay Question to Dr. Randi Dorn, Consortium Director (rdorn@mspp.edu) between December 5, 2011 and January 3, 2012. Also e-mail this application information in this timeframe to the Director(s) of Training for the Consortium internship site to which you are applying.

Attach 3 PDF letters of reference with electronic application materials if available at that time. If not available, please indicate who will be providing letters on your behalf.

All interested applicants will be interviewed.

The internship generally begins in mid August or early September, depending on the track. The MSPP Internship Consortium stipend is \$8500 per training year.

Candidates must indicate in their cover letter to which training track they would like to be considered. The following options will be available for the coming year:

Faulkner Hospital/Rhode Island College

This is a two year half time internship. The first year will be at Faulkner Hospital for 27 hours per week for 10 months. The second year will be at the Rhode Island College Counseling Center for 27 hours per week for 10 months.

Lynn Community Health Center

This is a two year half time internship that meets the criteria for the MSPP Clinical Health Psychology Track, the General Clinical Track, the Child and Family Concentration and/or the Latino Mental Health Program. Twenty-seven hours per week for 10 months (Sept-June) for two consecutive years.

Roger Williams University Center for Counseling and Student Development

This is a two year half time internship. Twenty-seven hours per week for 10 months (Sept-June) for two consecutive years. Please note that this track will **NOT** be taking Consortium interns for the 2012-2013 training year.

Wediko Childrens Services

This is a two year half time internship that meets the criteria for the MSPP Child and Family concentration or General Clinical Track as well as the Latino Mental Health Program. Twenty-seven hours per week for 10 months (September-June) for two consecutive years. Opportunity for paid summer program work for July and August following the second year at site.
